Item No. 1 - Call to Order

President Muirhead called the KMEA Lifesize Virtual Board of Directors meeting to order at 1:32 p.m. A quorum was present.

Item No. 2 – Approve the Minutes of the October 3, 2019 Board of Directors meeting

Jon Quinday made a motion to approve the minutes of the October 3, 2019, Board of Directors meeting, as presented. The motion was seconded by Manny Milbers and carried unanimously.

Item No. 3 – Take action to adopt Resolution No. 221, consenting to withdrawal of a member (Attica); and approving and providing for the execution of an Amendment to the Agreement Creating the Agency (29^{th}) reflecting such withdrawal by the member

Dennis Tharp made a motion to adopt Resolution No. 221. The motion was seconded by Michael Ort and carried unanimously.

Item No. 4 – Review the 2021 Annual Budget and take action to adopt the 2021 Annual Budget

Jennifer Moore presented the 2021 Annual Budget which now includes Mid-States and Linemen Services and highlighted the variances from the 2020 Annual Budget. A brief discussion was held on the potential expansion of the Linemen Services Project to Southeast Kansas. It was decided that if an additional line crew is brought on in 2021, the budget would be revised at that time.

Robert Mills made a motion to adopt the 2021 Annual Budget, as presented. The motion was seconded by Rob Lessen and carried unanimously.

Item No. 5 – Receive Nominating Committee Report and take action to elect Officers, Executive Committee members and Joint Board Executive Committee representative President Muirhead called upon Tyson McGreer, Chair of the Nominating Committee, to present the slate of candidates for this year's elections. Jon Quinday and Matt Rehder also served on this year's Nominating Committee.

Tyson McGreer presented the following slate of candidates:

President Muirhead called for nominations from the floor. No other nominations were made.

Chris Weiner made a motion to accept the slate of candidates for Officers, At-Large Members, and Joint Board Executive Committee representative, as presented. The motion was seconded by Lucas Neece and carried unanimously.

Mike Muirhead continued to reside over the meeting as Greg DuMars was unable to attend today's meeting. Paul Mahlberg thanked Mike Muirhead for his eight years of service and highlighted major KMEA accomplishments during his tenure. He also shared a letter from Garden City City Manager Matt Allen, which provided a short description of the positive impact Mike has provided to the City of Garden City's electric utility.

Item No. 6 – General Manager Report

Paul Mahlberg reported that 2020 was a unique and unusual year with the COVID-19 pandemic. He provided a brief review of 2020 activities and accomplishments, which include:

- New Revenue Stream Continuation and renegotiation of a "no risk" contract with a third-party allowing KMEA to optimize the value of members SPP transmission service,
- New EMP Members addition of six new EMP3 cities, effective June 1,
- Regulatory and Rates addition of a rates and regulatory staff member to provide financial and rate reviews, as well as monitor regulatory matters that could potentially impact our members,
- Engineering/Construction Project involvement in major engineering/construction projects for the cities of Anthony and Moundridge,
- Linemen Services signed contract with the City of Dighton May 1st with plans to expand to regional service, and
- Mid-States Purchase closed on purchase of assets of Mid-States Energy Works on July 1st.

Paul also provided a quick look at 2021 efforts, which include:

- Mid-States further integration into KMEA and managing backlog and growth,
- Large Scale Solar continued efforts to identify project in the 2024-25 timeframe,
- Community Solar assist members interested in community solar with RFPs, vendor selection, contract negotiations, etc.,
- New EMP Members Moundridge (2021) and Oberlin (2022)
- Linemen Crew Efforts "Regionalize" Dighton Crew and continue efforts in other parts of the State,
- Long-Term Power Supply Planning GRDA expiration in 2026 (28 Cities).
