Item No. 1 – Call the Meeting to Order

President Gus Collins called the meeting to order at 2:01 p.m., which was held virtually via Microsoft Teams. A quorum was present.

Item No. 2 – Consideration of Resolution No. 72 authorizing the execution of a Gas Supply Agreement with Minnesota Municipal Gas Agency (Natural Gas Prepay Option)

Paul Mahlberg provided a presentation on KMGA’s efforts related to natural gas prepay options that KMGA has been considering. He explained that the Minnesota group, composed of Minnesota Municipal Gas Agency and J. P. Morgan, are moving forward with their prepay. This group is asking for our interest in being an off-taker and, if so, to provide such interest in the form of the proposed Resolution No. 72.

Paul further explained the major terms and conditions of the proposed Gas Supply Agreement. In addition, he reviewed the recommended volumes and potential savings of the prepay if KMGA were to move forward. The minimum discount for the initial discount period is \$0.36/MMBtu with a guaranteed minimum discount for the remaining term set at \$0.23/MMBtu. The contract also provides that MMGA receives a \$0.04/MMBtu administration fee which would be netted against any discount.

Paul stated that to move forward on the prepay, KMGA needs the Executive Committee’s approval of Resolution No. 72, authorizing the general manager of KMGA to execute a gas supply agreement with Minnesota Municipal Gas Agency (MMGA). He said the net discount would be no less than \$0.32/MMBtu for the initial period and the net discount for the remaining term will be no less than \$0.19/MMBtu. Paul noted there’s a typo in the resolution of \$0.20/MMBtu and that it will be amended and needs to be reflected in any motion made to pass the resolution. He reviewed the sequential sections of the gas supply agreement within Resolution No. 72. Paul asked for the Executive Committee’s feedback and discussion ensued.

Tara Pierce made a motion to pass Resolution No. 72 authorizing the execution of a Gas Supply Agreement with Minnesota Municipal Gas Agency (Natural Gas Prepay Option), per an amendment to change the typo on the net discount for the remaining term from \$0.20/MMBtu to \$0.19/MMBtu. Jason Thrasher seconded the motion, and the motion carried unanimously.

Item No. 3 – Adjourn Meeting

The meeting was adjourned at 2:45 p.m.
