**Item No. 1 – Call the Meeting to Order**

President Gus Collins called the meeting to order at 10:31 a.m., which was held in McPherson, KS, and virtually. A quorum was present.

**Item No. 2 – Seek Approval for the Following Items:**

- **June 25, 2025, Executive Committee Meeting Minutes**  
Ethan Reimer made a motion to approve the minutes of the Executive Committee meeting held on June 25, 2025. The motion was seconded by Tara Pierce and carried unanimously.
- **Appropriations Report for June 2025**  
Mike Meyer presented the June 2025 Appropriations Report. Nathan Law made a motion to approve the June 2025 Appropriations Report. Ethan Reimer seconded the motion, and the motion was carried unanimously.

**Item No. 3 – Gas Director Report**

Dixie Riedel provided updates on the Natural Gas Industry market, including market updates for the week ending July 16, 2025.

**Item No. 4 – General Counsel Report**

Terri Pemberton provided updates on the KCC docket for Black Hills Energy, which has entered settlement. Currently there are no new updates on the Winter Storm Uri related class-action lawsuits in Kansas and the Oklahoma AG cases. The defendants in the class-action lawsuits will be filing an answer in August.

**Item No. 5 – General Manager Report**

Paul Mahlberg provided updates on work being completed at the KMEA office. Repair work to water-damaged interior walls is nearly complete and exterior walls should be finished next week; there was also an unplanned plumbing repair completed recently on a drain line in the kitchen. Development of the proposed new Mid-States facility is moving along, and KMEA may be ready to close on the land purchase next month, with plans to seek full board approval during the meeting in November. Paul also talked about this year's Annual Gathering, planned for September 11<sup>th</sup>. Paul encouraged everyone to attend if possible.

**Item No. 6 – Old Business**

- **Natural Gas Prepay Update**

Paul Mahlberg said that KMGGA is now prepared to move forward on the prepay when the market is ready. We've received agreements back from two groups: Black Belt/Goldman Sachs and MMGA/JP Morgan and the agreements are nearly identical so KMGGA could go with either group. Market conditions are currently marginal but when the market is ready, KMGGA will need approval from the Executive Committee and a resolution to move forward, so a special meeting may be needed.

**Item No. 8 – Executive Session**


